Development Project Stage 1

Project brief:

The Queensland Department of State Development, along with six other Queensland agencies, required accurate and detailed analysis of unsatisfied demand from Queensland's largest dam.

An in-depth demand assessment was required in order to inform the later stages of the project.

Psi Delta's role:

Perform intensive site-based research to assess demand in the areas of irrigation, urban use and mining

Apply knowledge of water markets and water entitlement/allocation rules

Produce results to inform major policy and budget decisions

Our achievements:

A detailed, easy-to-access database of identified demands was created.

The demand assessment was completed on time, within a very tight schedule.

Our work provided the client with data on which to base Stages 2-7 of the project.
